What is your teaching philosophy?

Why do you want to work at this university?

Why do you want this position?

What courses have you taught?

What courses would you like to teach?

What courses, not currently offered in our program, would you like to develop?

Describe your plans for research. What are you currently working on? What would you like to work on for the next several years?

How do you plan to support your research?

In what journals and books have you published?

In what journals do you plan to submit your research in the future?

What are your plans for publishing in the next few years?

How does your research inform your teaching?

Do you have plans for integrating students into your research? If so, please explain how?
